




Q1 How many years have you attended this church?






Q3 What is your gender?


Q5 Are you involved in a 4G Group/small group? Answered: 173 Skipped: 3



Q6 Are you involved in serving in a ministry of Calvary Baptist Church outside of attending services?




Q7 Our congregation is focused on maintaining traditional patterns of functioning versus trying new things and approaches to ministry.




Q8 Our congregation is representative of the population of Bastrop County versus very different from the population of Bastrop County




Q9 Our church is focused primarily on serving church members versus serving the surrounding community.









Q17 What is the minimum amount of professional ministry experience you believe our new pastor should have? (Pick One)




