Main Idea:

How do I know I am saved?



Key Verse: Matthew 7:21-23

²¹ Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven. ²² On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, didn't we prophesy in your name, drive out demons in your name, and do many miracles in your name?' ²³ Then I will announce to them, 'I never knew you. Depart from me, you lawbreakers!'



Set it Up:

How can you know that you are a Christian? When you became a Christian, you probably heard the words, "you are saved." But do you know why you were saved?



Was it because of something good you did? No! Christians practice healthy habits like praying and reading the Bible to grow as a Christian, but these activities are a response to being saved.

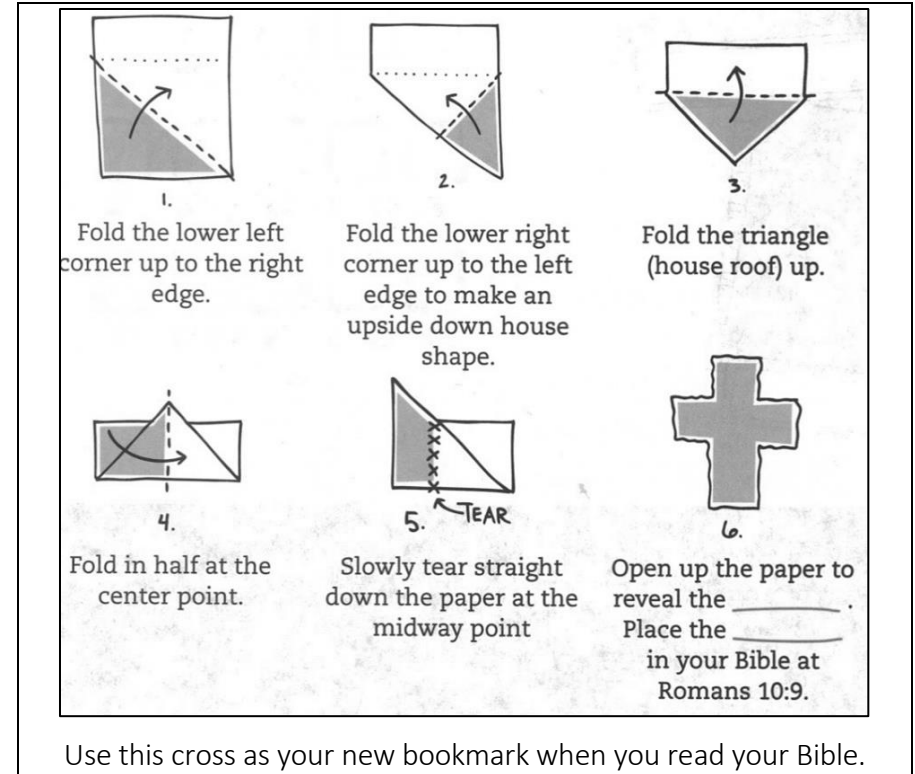


Activity:
