Main Idea:

Everyone Matters to God



Key Verse: 1 Corinthians 12:14-17

¹⁴ Indeed, the body is not one part but many. ¹⁵ If the foot should say, "Because I'm not a hand, I don't belong to the body," it is not for that reason any less a part of the body. ¹⁶ And if the ear should say, "Because I'm not an eye, I don't belong to the body," it is not for that reason any less a part of the body. ¹⁷ If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?



Ask:

If you could have any talent, what would it be?

We all wish we had talents that we do not have and sometimes we focus too much on these. But is that what we should be focused on?

Discussion:

We have so many parts that make up our bodies. We have hands and feet, legs and arms, a heart and brain, and more! All of these are important. You might not think something like a pinky toe is that significant, but if something happened to yours, you sure would notice!

We need all our body parts, and they all work together for our bodies to function properly and move and do what we want them to do.

In the video, Paul described the church as a body. The church is the body of Christ, and it exists to do His work. All of us have jobs to do that help the church community just like all our body parts and organs have jobs to do.

Some people might teach or preach, others might sing or play music, and some might read Scripture, serve snacks, or vacuum! All these things are important. It takes people with all kinds of gifts who work together as a team to carry out God's plans. Everyone has a part to play. No one is less important because of what they do or don't do.

Everyone in this family has a job, too! The things we do for the church are important. We are a part of the body of Christ, and God has an important plan to use us. Whatever we do, our role is essential to the big picture. We must be open to whatever God might ask us to do. Only when we work together and fit together as a church, a body, do we make it all come together!
