Main Idea:

What We Put Our Faith In Matters



Key Verse: Deuteronomy 4:35 and 39

³⁵ You were shown these things so that you would know that the LORD is God; there is no other besides him.

³⁹ Today, recognize and keep in mind that the LORD is God in heaven above and on earth below; there is no other.



Set it Up:

Get everyone together and have them sit on the couch. Tell them that the couch is going to take us all to the ice cream shop.



Talk it Out:

Ask: Can this couch really take us to the ice cream shop? (No, it can't. No matter how much you believe, the couch can take us there, it is impossible, it's not going to happen.)

Now go out to the car and ask: Can the car take us to the store? (Yes, it can. It has done so in the past. It has proven to us that it was created to take us places and it has gone to the store and back before.)

If you can, go ahead and go to the store and get everyone a treat. On your way to the store, continue talking about the rest of this devotional.



Does it matter where we place our faith? It sure does! No matter how much we believed in the couch, it could never take us anywhere. But when we place our faith in the right thing, then we can complete the task.

Who should we place our faith in?

Re-read Deuteronomy 4:35 and 39 from the beginning of the devotional.
