LOOK BACK:

Point: Be light in a dark world – live your purpose and make an eternal difference.

- Share with the group how your ministry activity is advancing God’s kingdom.

Question: Someone share the story of *The Three Little Pigs*. What is the intended moral of the story? What similarities are there to what Jesus says in Matthew 7:24-27?

LOOK UP: Watch this week’s video on the 4G web page.

Recap: Wolves and storms are going to come – guaranteed. The question is, how prepared are we to face them? What we do before the trouble comes will determine how we face it. Building a strong structure on a firm foundation requires planning and hard work. It’s not just going to happen or be easily set up.

A well-built life starts by listening to and acting on what Jesus says. Both require intentionality. Listening may require seeking assistance to clear understanding. It takes planning and work. In the same way, acting requires decision making, choosing to do and follow through on what Jesus says – or not. And, as with any life choice, the journey starts with just one “yes!”

LOOK IN: Discussion

- Share how someone you know (maybe you) ruined their life with one simple bad choice that snowballed into a broken life.
- Share how someone you know (maybe you) turned their life around with one simple good choice that snowballed to a renewed life.
- Make a list of practical ways one can choose to make a simple “yes” to Jesus that can snowball to a well-built life.

LOOK FORWARD: Application

Point: A life built on Jesus will stand; building it starts with one yes.
